MEETING RULES  
INDIANA ASSOCIATION OF PSI IOTA XI INC.  
APRIL 21, 2012

1. All meetings will be called to order promptly.
2. The Credentials Committee Shall report the number of registered delegates. Delegates shall be seated ten (10) minutes prior to the opening of the meeting. A delegate shall be considered absent if not in her place with proper identification at the time of the credentials report.
3. Delegates shall check in with the Credentials Committee before each meeting. Delegates shall report to the Credentials Committee upon leaving or entering the meeting room while the meeting is in progress.
4. Delegates and non-delegates shall wear the official meeting badge during all functions of the meeting.
5. Each Active Chapter shall have two (2) official delegates and have two (2) votes.
6. Each Auxiliary Chapter may have one (1) official delegate and on (1) vote.
7. A Chapter shall not be eligible to vote in the State Meeting until all State dues, fees and fines are paid.
8. An official delegate will not be excused until voting is completed unless previously excused by the State President.
9. A delegate or non-delegate member wishing to speak to the assembly shall come forward to the microphone and address the Chair. After the Chair has recognized the member, the member shall identify herself by name, Chapter and town before addressing the assembly.
10. A majority of those registered who are eligible to vote shall constitute a quorum.
11. All motions, suggestions and reports presented verbally at the meeting must be given to the President in writing and in triplicate prior to their reading.
12. All announcements, communications and requests must be given to the Pages for delivery. When addressing a note to a delegate, indicate the Chapter, City, District and table number.
13. Debate during this meeting shall be limited to two (2) minutes for each speaker. No one may speak a second time until all others who wish to speak have spoken. No one may speak more than twice on the same question.
14. Debate on Bylaws and Proposed Projects is limited to ten (10) minutes per subject.
15. The adoption of projects shall require a majority vote.
16. Non-delegates shall be seated in areas appropriately marked and separated from the official delegates.
17. The President and Secretary shall appoint a committee of three (3) delegates from Chapters not represented on the Board to approve the minutes of this State Meeting.
18. Each Voting Delegate shall be individually responsible for attending the State Meeting. Those who do not attend, unless excused by the State President, shall be fined fifty dollars (\$50.00) per delegate.
19. Cell phones are to be turned off during the meeting. If you are expecting an emergency call, please leave your cell phone at the Credentials Committee Table.
